HADLEIGH WOODS CANINE GUIDELINES

- ALL DOGS MUST BE LICENSED BY THE TOWN OF WINDHAM.
- A COPY OF THE LICENSE MUST BE PROVIDED ANNUALLY TO THE BOD BY MAY 1ST.
- DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES OR UNDER THE CONTROL OF ITS WALKER.
- NO ANIMAL SHALL BE TIED TO ANY COMMON AREA OR RAILING UNLESS THE OWNER IS
 PRESENT.
- ALL EXCREMENT MUST BE PICKED UP IMMEDIATELY AND PROPERLY DISPOSED OF.
- ANY DAMAGE CAUSED BY A DOG TO A COMMON OR LIMITED COMMON AREA WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER OF THE ANIMAL TO REPAIR.
- IF DOG EXCREMENT IS NOT ATTENDED TO IMMEDIATELY, THE FOLLOWING INFRACTION GUIDELINE WILL BE IMPLEMENTED:
 - FIRST INFRACTION: PET OWNER WILL BE NOTIFIED BY THE LANDSCAPE COMMITTEE CHAIR PERSON AND DOCUMENTED.
 - SECOND INFRACTION: PET OWNER WILL BE NOTIFIED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOD AND DOCUMENTED.
 - IF INFRACTIONS CONTINUE, DOCUMENTED FINES WILL BE INSTITUTED IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:
 - AFTER BOD NOTIFICATION:
 - FIRST...\$25.00
 - SECOND...\$50.00
 - THIRD AND ANY THEREAFTER...\$100.00

IN THE EVENT THAT A DOG IS VISITING FOR AN EXTENDED PERIOD OF TIME, THE ABOVE RULES WILL APPLY TO THE GUEST DOG.
